2. This is a rider-only award! Once a medal is earned the rider cannot receive the same medal in that level.
3. Scores do not need to be earned in one year (2006 and subsequent competitions years are accepted). Scores can only be used once.
4. Scores determine the medal you can earn bronze, silver and gold at each level.
5. The awards are:
 - Bronze 60.00% - 64.99%
 - Silver 65.00% - 69.99%
 - Gold 70.00% +

Medal will be awarded at year-end banquet.

Riders must be NEVADA members at the time of the competition for all scores submitted. Submit six tests from your level. (At least one must be the highest test of your level.) For Schooling Level awards, a minimum of four scores must be NEVADA Schooling Shows; a maximum of two scores may be sanctioned or listed by VADA or by other VADA Chapters and must be USDF tests. For Licensed Show awards, the six scores submitted must be USDF tests from USEF licensed shows. In the case of both Schooling and Licensed Show awards, scores will be averaged. Four NEVADA volunteer hours required before scores can be considered. Entries must be post-marked not later than December 1 of the competition year. Submit to:

30. Command break and out - riders to execute commands when called

ATTIRE - This is a schooling show so attire is casual, but riders should be neatly dressed and must wear heeled shoes or boots. All junior riders must wear helmets.

ENTRY FEE - \$7.00 per class. No pre-registration required, please register upon arrival. Up to date Coggins required for all horses at registration. Checks payable to Dream Catchers.

CONCESSIONS – Available all day! Coffee, soda, lunch and bake sale items.

USED TACK SALE – to benefit Dream Catchers, bring tack to donate, and purchase things that Dream Catchers can't use.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

FITTING AND SHOWMANSHIP - a pattern will be posted - handlers are to execute the pattern with horses in hand

HALTER CLASS- horses to be led into the ring in hand. Horses will be judged on conformation, and movement

ADULT RIDER - Horses and ponies ridden by adults age 18 and over

JUNIOR RIDER - riders under 18

WALK ONLY EQUITATION- Riders may not enter a class that requires any other gait. Simple tests may be called for. To be judged on the performance of the rider

WALK/TROT/JOG - riders may not enter any class that requires a canter/lope

GAYP - go as you please – must do same gait every time judge calls GAYP

HUNTER - horses to be shown in hunter tack

GAITED HORSE/SADDLE SEAT – Open to gaited horses in saddle seat or western tack and saddle seat riders on all breeds. Horse should demonstrate good manners appear to be a pleasure to ride over long distances at a moderate speed. These are two gaits- walk and "show gait". Show gait can be flat-walk, running walk, trote, trocha, rack, or trot (Arabs, National Show Horse, Saddlebreds).

WESTERN - horses shown in western tack

SPORT HORSE UNDER SADDLE - horses shown in dressage or hunter tack - no kimberwick bits allowed.

PLEASURE classes - walk, trot, and canter

TR classes – Therapeutic Rider class -- horse leaders, sidewalkers, and/or floaters allowed. Riders entered in these classes must be a regular student at a NARHA center.

CHAMPIONSHIP – classes to be awarded places first through fifth, then champion and reserve champion after class is judged.
